LIGHTING OF THE FOURTH ADVENT CANDLE

The **third candle** calls us to accept that with God nothing is beyond possibility, for we serve a God who can do all things. We light the **fourth candle** as a call to faithful obedience to the ways of God. As we continue our Advent journey, let us hear what God has spoken, believe what God has promised, accept what God has revealed, and obey what God has commanded.
